







The Complex Novelty Space

Perplexity



Professionals in the Agile space (some thoughts)

Professionals operating in the complex novelty space:

- Are craftspersonalities demonstrating appropriate behavior (collaboractive, willing to act in concerted ways).
- Don't represent complexity as ordered and predictable.
- Do not promise certainty where there is none.
- Do not pretend being able to predict the inherently unpredictable.
- Do not mix up the path with a destination.
- Present simple rules, not misrepresent the problem as simple (which is simplistic).
