

Re-vers-ify (verb)

/ˌriːˈvəːsɪfʌɪ/


- (dictionary) To formulate anew in verse;
 To turn into verse again;
 To rework (a piece of verse) into a different form.
- 2. (Scrum) To restore organizational harmony; To re·imagine an organization's Scrum in order to re·emerge the structures around it.





To re-vers-ify an organization

 - 3. ADAPT your organization for value Repeat








To reversify an organization

Scrum /skr^m/

- (dictionary | noun) An ordered formation of players, used to restart play; (dictionary | verb) Form or take part in a Scrum.






Warning!

- The definition of value is likely to evolve over time.










An "ARMADA" of value!

Many ways to optimize your Scrum

- Committed, focused, engaged people
- Team effectiveness (collaboration, autonomy & self-organization)
- Skills & professional development (training)
- Development practices & standards
- Infrastructure, tooling & automation
- Quality standards & guidelines
- Elimination of low value
- Removal of Impediments
- A definition of "Done" that reflects valuable (beyond releasable)

Optimize your organization (forming Product Hubs)




A **product hub** operates like a start-up, setting its own agenda and taking its own initiatives.

- Management acts as an investor, not intervening on a daily base but rather providing guidance, money and moral support at the outset.
- Leadership becomes a distributed quality instead of an expression of individual assertiveness and dominance.






